Funding requests

- a) Attach pec/fly machine to floor (\$200 plus taxes) Approved by Fitness Committee
- Pec/fly machine needs to be attached to floor as it keeps sliding into VPB structures
- b) Upholstery project(\$404.31) Approved by Fitness Committee
- 3 pieces of equipment need to be re-upholstered, Top Surface can complete job overnight
- c) Rust removal project (\$1050 plus taxes) Pending approval via email
- Matrix supplied supplies to remove rust from equipment, cost covers 2 people from A-Tech to complete job
- d) Water bottle/fountain filling station upgrade (\$3000 plus taxes and shipping/window build up) Pending approval via email
- Looking to upgrade water fountain in fitness centre to accept filling bottles
- Manual fountain filling station (\$3000) plus VPB carpentry window build up
- e) Cardio equipment replacement x 4 (\$75 297.76) Pending approval via email
 - KFC treadmills and Life Fitness elliptical aging, parts are getting hard to find
 - Looking to replace all 5 treadmills and 1 elliptical over 2-3 year period
 - Staff recommend purchasing 2 treadmills and 1 elliptical (\$55 297.76)
 - Would like to increase request to 3 treadmills (+\$20,000)
 - o Funds from Restricted Reserve

MOTION: To approve a funding request of \$75 297.76 to purchase 3 treadmills and elliptical with Restricted Reserve Funds. Moved by Terry, Seconded by Jim; Pending approval

- f) Replacement of TVs in Fitness Centre (\$1600 plus taxes/shipping) Approved by Board via email
 - Two TVs in fitness centre over 15 years old and need to be replaced
 - Purchase two TVs between 40-43" to use as TV and for promotional purposes

- CUPE just finalized agreement with 4.5% increase 2023 and 4.0% 2024, 3.25% inflation bonus for 2022
- Contract language may state that CCA needs to follow CUPE agreement
 - Frank will assess contract and follow up

 - o If staff want to bring spouse, they may purchase a ticket if availability permits
- 4.03 Preschool Deficit (In Camera)
- Based on operating budget, preschool and OSC deficit at \$58,000
- Low enrollment, low demand for part-time preschool
- Suggest changing to full time daycare model, use one room for fitness centre, move OSC to another room
- Timeline for childcare project?
 - o Kitsilano site took about 2 years, required policy changes, construction
 - o Possibly start Sept 2025 season
